OUR JOURNEY

Speed of Sight was born in 2012, when Mike Newman BEM—our founder, a world-record-breaking blind driver—and his friend John Galloway set out to change lives. Since then, we've designed and built a growing fleet of vehicles, each lovingly named after Mike's guide dogs. In 2024, we celebrated the arrival of our sixth and seventh cars, thanks to Sigma Capital Group, MEV, the Ardonagh Community Trust and the Peter Harrison Foundation, pushing the limits of accessibility even further. With dual controls, twin steering wheels, and hand controls, our specially adapted racing cars and all-terrain buggies have made it possible for hundreds of individuals to experience the thrill of driving. From roaring engines to the wind rushing past, our participants don't just drive—they fly.



2024 HIGHLIGHTS

As well as adding our 6th and 7th vehicles to our fleet, this past year, Speed of Sight reached new heights, hosting 12 unforgettable Track Day events across eight incredible venues in England, Scotland, and Wales. We were thrilled to welcome 208 participants, each bringing their own story, their own courage, and their own determination to embrace the extraordinary. From young thrill-seekers under 17 to inspirational individuals over 76, our Track Days showed that age and ability are no barriers to adventure.





DRIVING IMPACT





97% rated the overall day 10 out of 10

In 2024, participant feedback from our Track Days painted a powerful picture of success:

- Over 97% of attendees rated the day overall as a perfect 10 out of 10.
- Over 96% gave their actual driving experience a flawless 10 out of 10.
- Across all categories—Car, Instructor, Staff, Venue, and Information Provided—we received **10 out of 10** scores in over 90% of all responses.
- Additionally, 100% of participants and their families said they would recommend the Speed of Sight driving experience to others.
- Inspiringly, 100% expressed a strong desire to return for another Track Day.

These results speak volumes about the transformative impact of our work, underscoring the joy, confidence, and unforgettable memories we create for participants and their families.

PARTICIPANT SPOTLIGHT



"The team did not underestimate Joe, they let him fly"

Our son, Joe, is 12. He has Down Syndrome. He watched his older brother take part in a "mainstream" track experience and said, 'I want to do that,' but he could not access the mainstream experience. We researched and found Speed of Sight. Today Joe had his track experience. It was amazing. The team made him feel special – because it was his day, his treat – but they did not make him feel 'special needs.'They treated him with dignity and respect, and he responded by following all of the instructions that he was given, so that he was able to drive a Caterham, fast, around a racing track.





We know that our son is capable of **reaching for the sky**, but all too often it is **easy to underestimate** a child with a learning disability. The team did not underestimate Joe, they **let him fly**.I am crying now, thinking about watching him go round that track, and the **enormous smile** on his face when he had finished. This is a great team, giving disabled people the opportunity to **reach their potential** and to be able to experience what any other petrol head takes for granted.


